WHAT'S NEW FOR RECONCILOR 9.1.8

Reconcilor embeds and integrates the knowledge from our mining engineers, geologists, metallurgists and planners and when it is used to standardise operations across multiple sites, it enables sophisticated analysis and guidance to trouble-shoot and optimise multiple sites.

Snowden's Reconcilor has been developed to deliver this as a COTS (Commercial Off-the-Shelf) offering, with the added potential to enhance or supersede the existing functionality present in earlier versions of the product. Reconcilor assists key stakeholders on site and at head office to quickly see how operations are performing, get early notification of any issues and take action to resolve them.

This is a **minor version** update for Reconcilor. It is focused on:

- Allowing comparisons of model versions of the same model type
- Improvements to the grade block screen

ENHANCEMENTS

Model versions

The Model Comparison and Trends modules allow single or multiple datasets for models to be compared over time, location, resource classification, material type or lithology type.

For every model type there is a model version that has been activated for a survey period. A model (type) can be comprised of different model versions over time.

Model Comparison Module

The Model Comparison module now allows comparisons of different model versions for the same period. This will provide the user with the ability to compare how model versions compare against haulage.

Trends Module

The Trends module will allow different model versions for the same period (regardless of if a model version is active for the period).

The Trends module will also allow different plan versions for the same period (regardless of if a mine plan version is active for the period). This will provide the user with the ability to compare how mine plan versions compare against haulage or model by survey.

Grade Block Module

The Grade Block module has had improvements to:

- Model by survey table
 - shows the design tonnes at the top of the table
 - application setting allows the reference survey model to be changed. If no survey exists for a site, then the model by survey table will show design tonnes only.
- Mining Activity chart display

- Extends the display a further month to provide better visualisation of the difference between survey tonnes and haulage tonnes.
- Information table
 - now compiled from grade block information rather than model cells rolled up to block level.
- Application Settings > Grade Block Settings
 - A new option to select “None”
